1. I am a MN POST-Licensed peace officer and have been employed by the Apple Valley Minnesota Police Department since 2004. I have been a member of the Dakota County Electronics Crimes Task Force (“DCECTF”) since it was created in early 2015.
2. In 2014-2015 I participated in investigating the deaths of three persons whose bodies were found in a single-family residence at 1051 Ramsdell Drive in the City of Apple Valley. My investigative responsibilities consisted of: forensic examinations of digital evidence.
3. I have reviewed the attached document entitled “Examination Report” placed upon alleged letterhead, dated October 5, 2015 and states that I prepared the report.
4. Prior to seeing this document during August 2021, I had never seen this document. I am absolutely not the creator of that document. Further, I have reviewed the applicable Case File #15000303 maintained by the Apple Valley Police Department and did not locate this document.



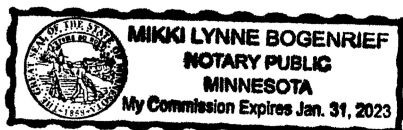

Attached is the full examination report regarding 1051 Ramsdell Drive - Crowley Family. As you can tell from the photo's and journal entries there was widespread drug use to include a plethora of illicit drugs and the perpetrator (David Crowley) had not slept in many days. From the evidence we were able to obtain, we believe that he was using substances to remain awake and the journal entries show him becoming increasingly agitated. Although we cannot say with 100% certainty, what set the wheels in motion. We believe the actual incident occurred on either December 24, 2014 or December 25, 2014 and that the substances as well as sleep deprivation contributed. As discussed, our evidence coupled with BCA's co-investigation concur with your findings that the adult female was shot first from a short distance, the minor child was then shot at close range and placed near the adult female and at some point later, the male perpetrator turned the weapon on himself and discharged it causing his subsequent death.

We will be closing our case file to reflect the same. Please let us know if we can be of any further assistance.
